PROCEDURE

STEP 1 Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface; turn off the ignition and allow the engine to cool.

STEP 2 As shown in PIC 1, test fit the plastic reducers to the axle end and nut. If the reducers fit over, then the reducers will need to be used. If they do not fit, proceed to Step 6.

STEP 3 Remove the plastic reducer from the axle. Press the reducers in to the axle caps. The reducers press in to cut-outs inside the axle caps.

NOTE Once the reducers are snapped in to place, they are difficult to remove.

STEP 4 Thread the $10-24 \times 3/8$ " set screws in to the holes in the axle cap.

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STEP 5 Place an axle cap with reducer installed over the nut and axle end. Tighten the set screws to hold the axle caps in place.

STEP 6 For the large axles and axle nuts (do not need the plastic reducer), thread the $10-24 \times 1/4$ " set screws in to the holes in the axle cap.

STEP 7 Place the axle cap over the nut and axle end. Tighten the set screws to hold the axle caps in place.
