STEP 1

Read and understand all STEPS in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn IGN OFF. Remove the main fuse.

STEP 2

Refer to PIC 1. Remove existing turn signal assembly; disconnect the light connectors, and remove factory standoff mounting studs. Set the assembly and hardware aside, it will not be reused. Repeat for other side. If motorcycle is equipped with Kuryakyn tie downs, skip to STEP 5, otherwise proceed to the next step.

STEP 3 Refer to PIC 2. Locate the Right Driving Light assembly. Mate the connectors.


STEP 4

Refer to PIC 3. Assemble two of the included screws with one flat washer each; insert one screw and washer assembly through the top hole and one through the bottom hole of the driving light assembly. On the inside of the assembly, place a thick spacer over the bottom screw, and a thin spacer over the top screw. Neatly tuck connector wires in cavity of light assembly, and secure it in place on the bike.

Repeat for other side.

IF MOTORCYCLE IS EQUIPPED WITH KURYAKYN TIE DOWNS, FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING STEPS BELOW.

STEP 5

Locate Hardware Kit. Assemble two of the included screws with one flat washer each; insert one screw and washer assembly through the top hole and one through the bottom hole of the driving light assembly.

STEP 6

Route Driving Light assembly wiring through the slot in the tie down, and place tie down bracket over the screw ends. Route the wiring into the fairing cavity.

STEP 7

Align tie down bracket and light assembly on the bike, and secure in place with screws.

Repeat for other side.

ADJUSTING THE DRIVING LIGHTS

MARNING

STEP 1

Refer to PIC 6. For up and down adjustment, loosen the fastener that secures the light assembly to the mount and tilt the assembly in the desired direction. When the light is in the desired position, tighten the fastener securely.

STEP 2

Refer to PIC 6. For side to side adjustment, loosen the fastener that secures the knuckle to the mounting bracket and rotate the assembly in the desired direction. When the light is in the desired position, tighten the fastener securely.

Refer to PIC 7. Remove the Button Head Cap Screw located at the bottom of the STEP 1 light housing.



Remove the light bezel by twisting the bezel counter clockwise and pulling the bezel outward.




Remove the rubber inner seal from the light housing. The glass light housing should now be free.


Note: Please note the orientation of the locating ring. This will greatly help when reassembling the lights. Refer to PIC 9.

STEP 4

Refer PIC 8. Pull the glass housing out way from the light housing and disconnect the wires.

STEP 5 Refer PIC 9. Remove the screws to gain access to the light bulb. Pull the light bulb from the mount, with the white wire attached.

STEP 6 Take the new light and insert the white wire through the mount from the front side. (The wire should fit through the rubber boot on the backside of the


ALCOHOL BEFORE INSTALLATION.

STEP 7 Reassemble the glass housing and the light housing in the reverse order they

were disassembled.
