Standard hex bit set and socket set, ft-lbs and in-lbs (Nm) torque wrench

STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

STEP 2

Remove main fuse.

# STEP 3

### FOR ELECTRA GLIDES AND TRIKES:


Refer to PIC 2. Unfasten the turn signal bracket, disconnect the turn signals, and remove turn signal assembly.

### FOR ROAD GLIDE ULTRAS:

Refer to PIC 3. Unfasten and remove windshield. Unfasten the outer fairing, disconnect the turn signal wires located near the top of the outer fairing, and remove the outer fairing.

Note: Refer to motorcycle's service manual for additional assistance.





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### -CONTINUED-

STEP 4 Refer to PIC 4 or 5. Locate provided Run Turn Wire Adapters. Connect an adapter to each turn signal wire harness on the motorcycle.

STEP 5 Locate provided left (clutch side) and right (brake side) L.E.D. Grill Inserts. Connect the left light to a left wiring adapter and the right light to a right wiring adapter.

STEP 6 Reinstall main fuse and test lights for proper run/turn operations. Disconnect lights after operational testing. Set them aside for the time being. Remove main fuse.

STEP 7 Refer to PIC 6. Using a flat edge tool, remove the lower front grills from the outside lower fairings.

STEP 8 Refer to PIC 7. From the inside of the lower fairing, remove the two (2) screws securing the cover to the inside. Do not remove cover. Set hardware aside, it will be reused.

STEP 9 Refer to PIC 8. On the front side of the lower fairing, insert the cord through an opening in the grill area. Route the wire through to the other side.

**STEP 10** Refer to PIC 9. On the inside of the lower fairing, gently pry back the cover that had the screws removed from it in Step 8. Pull the L.E.D. grill's cord through the cover.

STEP 11 Refer to PIC 10 and 11. On the front side of the lower fairing, align and snap the L.E.D. grill into place.

STEP 12 Route the L.E.D. grill's cord along the side of the lower fairing and the inside-side of the fork. Pull the plug through the hole in the fork assembly where the turn signal harness is. Connect the L.E.D. grill to the attached wire adapter.

#### **STEP 13 FOR ELECTRA GLIDES AND TRIKES:**

Refer to PIC 12. Connect the OEM turn signal to the adapter, and reinstall the turn signal bracket and assembly. Repeat on opposite side.

TORQUE VALUE FOR FORK MOUNTED TURN SIGNALS WITHOUT AUXILIARY/FOG LAMPS: 15-20 ft-lbs (20.3-27.1 Nm)

TORQUE VALUE FOR FORK MOUNTED TURN SIGNALS WITH AUXILIARY/FOG LAMPS: 96-120 in-lbs (10.9-13.25 Nm)

### **FOR ROAD GLIDE ULTRAS:**

Refer to PIC 13. Connect the OEM turn signals to the adapters, and reinstall the outer fairing and windshield.

TORQUE VALUE FOR OUTER FAIRING UPPER SCREWS (NEAR SPEAKERS): 20-30 in-lbs (2.3-3.4 Nm)


TORQUE VALUE FOR OUTER FAIRING LOWER SCREWS (ALSO AIR DEFLECTOR): 8-15 in-lbs (0.9-1.4 Nm)

**TORQUE VALUE FOR WINDSHEILD SCREWS:** 8-12 in-lbs (0.9-1.4 Nm)

**STEP 14** Use provided Cable Ties, Cord Keepers, and Cable Tie Mounts to fasten the grills' wire around the fork and lower fairing area. Be sure to fasten the wires where they won't pinch, pull, or be damaged.

**STEP 15** Reinstall main fuse and test lights for proper run/turn operations.

- 3. Kuryakyn shall not be liable for any consequential & incidental damages, including labor & paint, resulting from failure of a Kuryakyn product, failure to deliver, delay in delivery, delivery in nonconforming condition, or for any breach of contract or duty between Kuryakyn & a customer.
- 4. Kuryakyn products are often intended for use in specific applications. Kuryakyn makes no warranty if a Kuryakyn product is used in applications other than intended.
- 5. Kuryakyn electrical products are warranted for one (1) year from the date of purchase by the consumer. L.E.D.'s contained in components of Kuryakyn products will be warranted for defects in materials & workmanship for 3 years from the date of purchase whereas all other components shall be warranted for one (1) year.
- 6. All warranty claims must be directed to the place of purchase. Merchandise sold through internet auction sites or any other unauthorized reseller shall not carry a Kuryakyn warranty. If unsure, please contact the place of purchase to verify they are an authorized Kuryakyn reseller.

Merchandise determined to be defective may be returned up to one year from the date of purchase. Returns must be processed through original seller. Returned merchandise for any other reason other than warranty claims must be in like new condition & subject to a 20% restocking fee. All returns are subject to inspection for determination of full or partial credit. Any returned part that shows evidence of being used or installed contrary to manufacturer's instructions, &/or subjected to improper handling, packaging or return shipping by the customer, will not be eligible for exchange, refund or warranty consideration. All returned electrical items will be inspected & tested. If electrical item is deemed functional, no credit will be issued & item will be returned. All sales are final on discontinued or closeout merchandise.

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
