STEP 1

Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.

THIS FIXED MOUNT KIT IS INTENDED TO BE USED WITH MULTI-PURPOSE BACKREST (P/N 1660 OR 1661 - SOLD SEPARATELY).

STEP 2 Refer to PIC 2. Working on one side of the motorcycle at a time, remove rear fender support hardware. Set hardware aside, it will not be reused.

STEP 3 Refer to PIC 3. Locate provided one (1) Front Spacer and one (1) Rear Spacer. Remove the adhesive backer from the backside of the spacers. Align and place the rear spacer in the rear mounting hole of the fender support, and the front spacer on the front mounting hole of the fender support.

STEP 4 Locate Right (brake-side) Mount.

STEP 5 Refer to PIC 4. Locate provided two (2) 3/8-16 X 1-1/2" Button Socket Cap Screws. Apply a small amount of blue loctite to each screw. Align and place the Right Mount with the rear fender support. Secure mount in place with the provided screws. Fully tighten hardware.

> TORQUE VALUE FOR REAR FENDER SUPPORT SCREW: 12-18 ft-lbs (16.3-24.4 Nm)

STEP 6 Refer to PIC 5. Repeat steps 2 through 5 for the left (clutch)

STEP 7 Locate Multi-Purpose Backrest (P/N 1660 or 1661 - sold separately). Test fit the backrest between the fixed mounts. The Backrest should slide easily between the fixed mounts.

STEP 8 Refer to PIC 6 through 8. Install the backrest to the Fixed Mounts by inserting one of the supplied (with the backrest) 5/16"-18 X 7/8" countersunk socket head cap screws through one of the supplied shoulder washers, through the Fixed Mount and threading it to the Driver/Passenger Backrest on each side. Fully tighten hardware. If these fasteners are loosened or removed, see WARNING! below.

> **TORQUE VALUE FOR BACKREST SCREWS:** 15 FT-LBS (20.34 NM)

**BOTH PIVOT/HINGE SCREWS MUST HAVE THREAD LOCK** COMPOUND RE-APPLIED AND RE-TORQUED ONCE REMOVED, AFTER INITIAL INSTALLATION, FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RESULT IN UNINTENDED LOOSENING AND MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH. THE FEMALE THREADS IN THE MULTI-PURPOSE BACKREST AND THE THREADS ON THE REMOVED SCREWS WILL NEED TO BE CLEANED TO REMOVE ANY THREAD LOCK RESIDUE BEFORE RE-INSERTING. RE-APPLY LOCTITE® THREAD LOCK BLUE 242® OR EQUIVALENT, AS SHOWN IN PIC 9, RE-TORQUING TO 15 ft-lbs (20.3 Nm) USING A TORQUE WRENCH AND 3/16" ALLEN/HEX KEY ATTACHMENT. LET CURE PER THE THREAD LOCK MANUFACTURERS INSTRUCTIONS AFTER INSTALLATION. IF YOU DO NOT WISH TO APPLY THREAD LOCK, THEN ORDER A NEW SERVICE KIT, (P/N 991660) WHICH WILL CONTAIN SCREWS WITH BLUE THREAD LOCK ADHESIVE PRE-APPLIED.

STEP 9

Refer to PIC 10 and 11. Check the operation of the Backrest by folding the locking levers to the straight out position. Lower or raise the backrest to the desired location. Fold the locking levers over to lock them in place. Gently rock the Backrest back and forth to ensure the locking pins are engaged in the notches in the Fixed Mounts. Repeat for the other position of the Backrest. Visually inspect the Shoulder Washers and Countersunk Socket Head Cap Screws at the pivot point for any signs of loosening before each ride. Kuryakyn requires checking all backrest attaching fasteners to the torque specifications defined in these instructions every 3,000 to 5,000 miles.

Note: See instructions for Multi-Purpose Driver/Passenger Backrest, P/N 1660 or P/N 1661, for adjustment procedures.
